Men's Fellowship

Thanks to all who attended our Italian Festival on Saturday, April 28. We enjoyed an evening of great food, fellowship, and music while raising funds for our mission projects.

Missions:

The Missions Committee is looking forward to Blanket Sunday which will be held this Sunday May 13th which is Mother's Day. The congregation will be asked to purchase blankets for Church World Service which will use the blankets for refugees and homeless persons. Blankets can be purchased in honor of or in memory of Mothers, Grandmothers, or other loved ones at a cost of \$10 per blanket. Emmanuel children will demonstrate many different ways that blankets can be used for relief. Consider purchasing several blankets.

Food collected for the month of April will be donated to the Ridgewood Board of Social Services. Food collected in May will go to The Center for Food Action. A list of food items most needed is posted by the food box in the hall outside the sanctuary. More food is needed by both agencies.

A trip to visit Camp Lebanon, our NJ Baptist Camp, is now scheduled for Sunday afternoon, June 3rd. The purpose of this trip will be introduce children and adults from Emmanuel to our camp. Several children from EBC have had very meaningful experiences at Lebanon. Also, Emmanuel has made a pledge to donate \$10,000 to a fundraiser for the camp called "Cedars of Lebanon". This pledge will need to be paid by January, 2020. Perhaps visitors can take a picnic on June 3rd. The camp is about 1 and 1/2 hours away. Let David Davila or Nancy Shaver know if you are interested in going.
